Are you funded by Student Finance and thinking of withdrawing from your course?

What you need to know.

Depending on the date of your withdrawal, Student Finance may not pay your full tuition fee liability, so a portion of your fee may be re-invoiced to you to pay back directly to the University.

Tuition fee liability 0%

If you leave within the first three weeks of the start of semester one (26th September 2016 up to and including 17th October 2016) no fees are due. Neither you, nor Student Finance will be charged.

No tuition fees due

Tuition fee liability 50%

If you withdraw after week three (18th October 2016 up to and including 2nd January 2017) your tuition fee liability with the University will be 50% of your fees (£4,000). Student Finance will only pay £2,000 and you will therefore be invoiced for the portion they will not pay - £2,000.

Student Finance to pay 25% (£2,000) Student to pay 25% (£2,000)

Tuition fee liability 50%

If you withdraw after 3rd January 2017, up to and including the start of semester two, 30th January 2017, your tuition fee liability with the University will still be 50% - £4,000 but Student Finance will fund the full 50% of your tuition fee.

Student Finance to pay 50% (£4,000)

Tuition fee liability 100%

If you withdraw after the start of semester two, (31st January 2017 up to and including the 9th April 2017), then your tuition fee liability is 100% (£8,000), however Student Finance will only pay 50% - £4,000. You will therefore be re-invoiced for the portion that they will not pay - £4,000.

Student Finance to pay 50% (£4,000) Student to pay 50% (£4,000)

Tuition fee liability 100%

If you withdraw after the 10th April 2017 your tuition fee liability with the University will still be 100% – £8,000 and Student Finance will pay 100% of your fees £8,000.

Student Finance to pay 100% (£8,000)

Please also be aware that, depending on the date of your withdrawal, this may also affect your maintenance payments from Student Finance. The above illustration is based on tuition fees of £8,000 for a September starter. Please note that if you have been awarded a fee waiver or fee reduction then this will impact your tuition fee liability.
